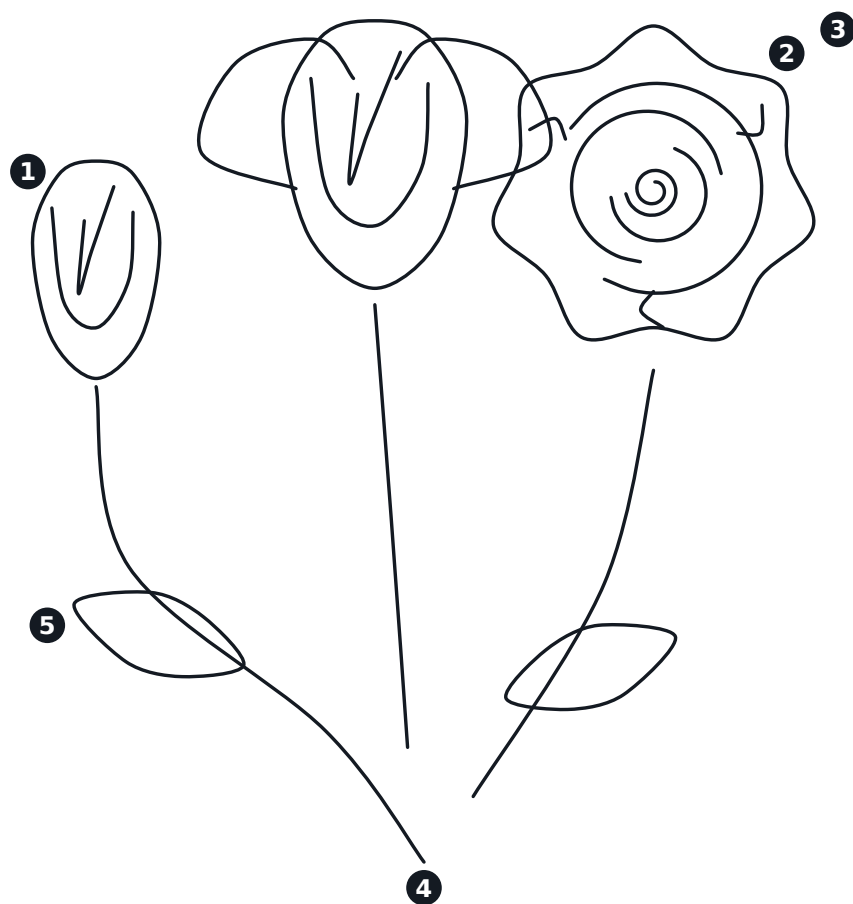


Rose Branch Embroidery Pattern with Three Stages

10.4 x 11.1 cm finished | 3 stitches | 5 threads | print at 100%

Trace the drawing onto your fabric. Each numbered circle is one line in the stitch key below.



Stitch key

- 1**  Stem stitch · SZ12 Rose · Bud and half open rose
work each outline anticlockwise, starting at the dot on the map, thread always on the same side
- 2**  Chain stitch · SZ14 Deep Berry · Open bloom silhouette
work the outline clockwise, starting at the dot on the map, each loop holding the last
- 3**  Back stitch · SZ13 Cherry Red · Petal curves and hearts
work each line left to right, one at a time
- 4**  Stem stitch · SZ25 Pine · Branch and stems
work each line down towards the right, one at a time, thread always on the same side
- 5**  Back stitch · SZ24 Leaf Green · Leaves
work each outline anticlockwise, starting at the dot on the map

You need: 2 strands · embroidery needle size 7 · any hoop or frame that clears the drawing

SZ12 Rose 1.0 m · SZ14 Deep Berry 80 cm · SZ13 Cherry Red 1.0 m · SZ25 Pine 80 cm

SZ24 Leaf Green 50 cm

Work order: 1 · 2 · 3 · 4 · 5

Stitch direction
