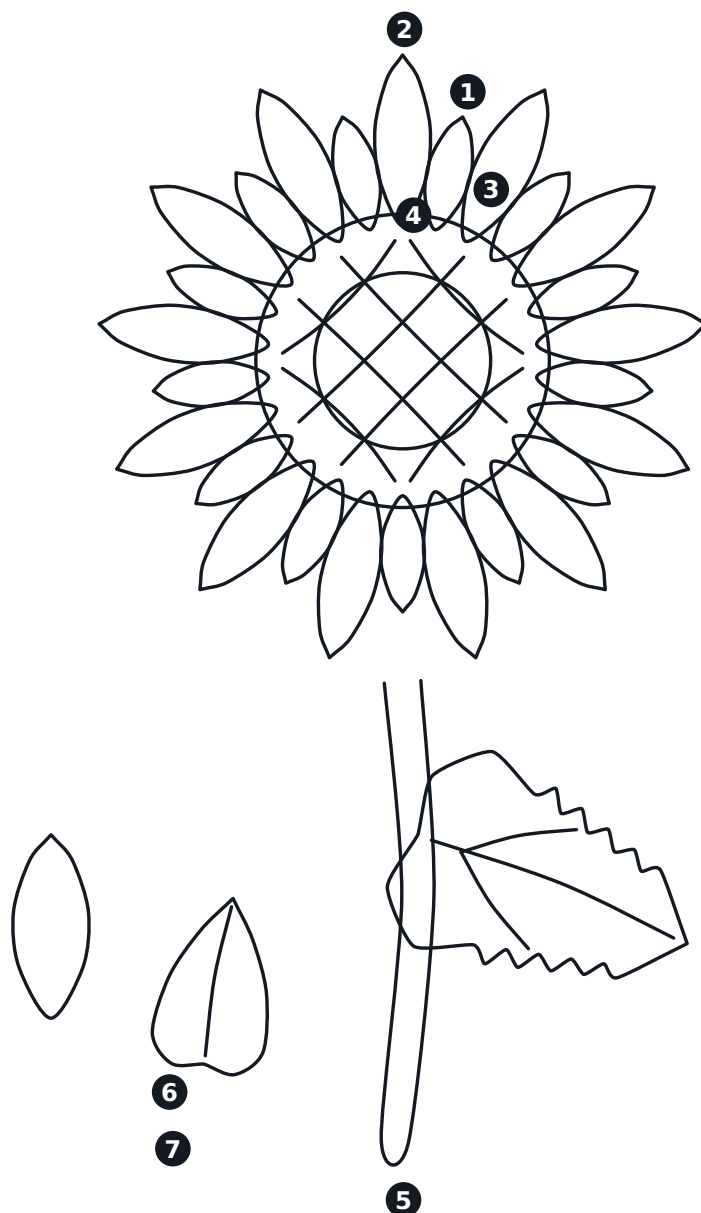


Botanical Sunflower Study Embroidery Pattern

9.2 x 14.8 cm finished | 5 stitches | 7 threads | print at 100%

Trace the drawing onto your fabric. Each numbered circle is one line in the stitch key below.



Stitch key

- 1** Stem stitch · SZ38 Mustard · Shorter back rays
work each outline anticlockwise, starting at the dot on the map, thread always on the same side
- 2** Chain stitch · SZ21 Sunflower · Front rays, one dissected
work each outline anticlockwise, starting at the dot on the map, each loop holding the last
- 3** Back stitch · SZ34 Chocolate · Disc rim and inner ring
work each outline clockwise, starting at the dot on the map
- 4** Couching · SZ35 Toffee · Seed spiral lattice
lay the long threads first, then tie them down with tiny crosses
- 5** Stem stitch · SZ23 Olive · Main stem
work the line left to right, thread always on the same side
- 6** Back stitch · SZ24 Leaf Green · Toothed leaves, one dissected
work each outline anticlockwise, starting at the dot on the map
- 7** Split stitch · SZ25 Pine · Vein work
work each line left to right, one at a time

You need: 2 strands · embroidery needle size 7 · any hoop or frame that clears the drawing

SZ38 Mustard 1.5 m · SZ21 Sunflower 3.0 m · SZ34 Chocolate 70 cm · SZ35 Toffee 60 cm

SZ23 Olive 60 cm · SZ24 Leaf Green 60 cm · SZ25 Pine 50 cm

Work order: 1 · 2 · 3 · 5 · 6 · 7 · 4
